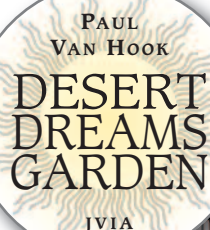
The Garden not only teaches us about drought-tolerant plants and trees, it also showcases donated artifacts from the early homestead era in Johnson Valley.

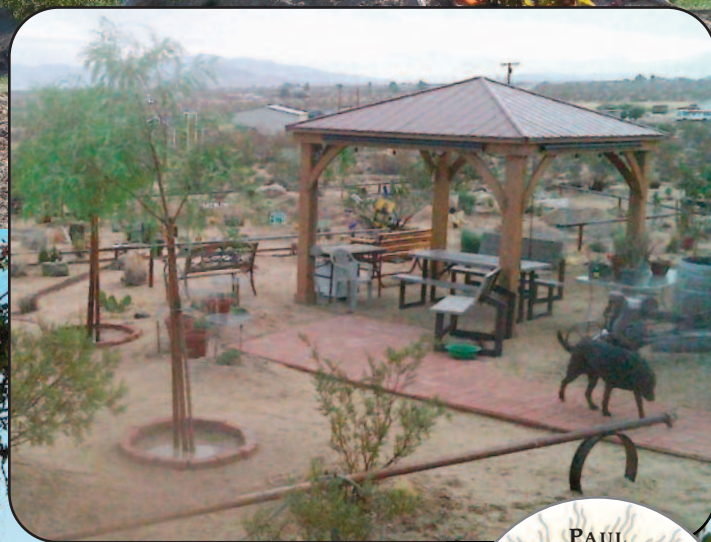

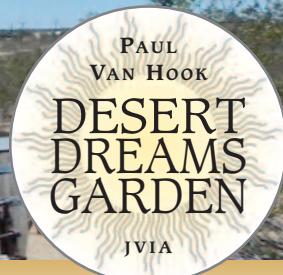

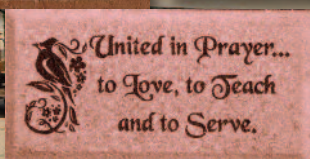
